



She first rose to fame in the 1960s partnering with her then-husband Ike Turner, achieving great acclaim for their live performances and catalogue of hits. Later, Turner enjoyed an international solo career with her 1984 album *Private Dancer*, earning her widespread recognition and numerous awards including three Grammys. She went on to deliver more charttopping albums and hits, receiving a further eight Grammy Awards and reportedly selling more concert tickets than any other solo performer in history. The revered singer was inducted into the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame in 1991 and again as a solo artist in 2021. She continues to be voted as one of the most successful female rock 'n' roll artists of all time.

KATORI HALL (Book). Memphis native Katori Hall is a Pulitzer Prize and Olivier Awardwinning playwright. 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


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
